

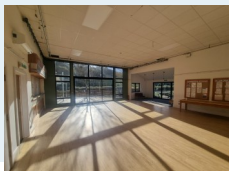
Hire Calstock Village Hall for your special occasion or wedding

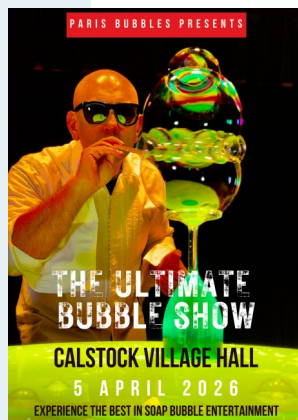
After their sell out gig last year and following the release of a new album, they are back. It is sure to be a truly funky night with support from DJ Funktopus.
